Resolution 2009-11
Senate Bill 737

Whereas; Senators Kahn and Switalski have introduced SB 737, which deals with uncontested elections; and,

Whereas; uncontested elections cause the undue expenditure of public funds; and,

Whereas; the proposed legislation allows local units of government the option to cancel an uncontested election after the deadline to file for a write-in candidate has elapsed; and,

Whereas; two of the last three elections held by the Village of Lake Isabella have been uncontested; and,

Whereas; revenue sharing to the Village of Lake Isabella has declined in recent years; and,

Now therefore be it resolved;

1. The Village of Lake Isabella supports the adoption of SB 737; and,
2. The Village of Lake Isabella requests that the Michigan Municipal League take a position in support of the proposed legislation; and,
3. Allowing local units of government the option to cancel an uncontested election should be permitted as a cost-cutting measure to help offset reductions in State Shared Revenue.
